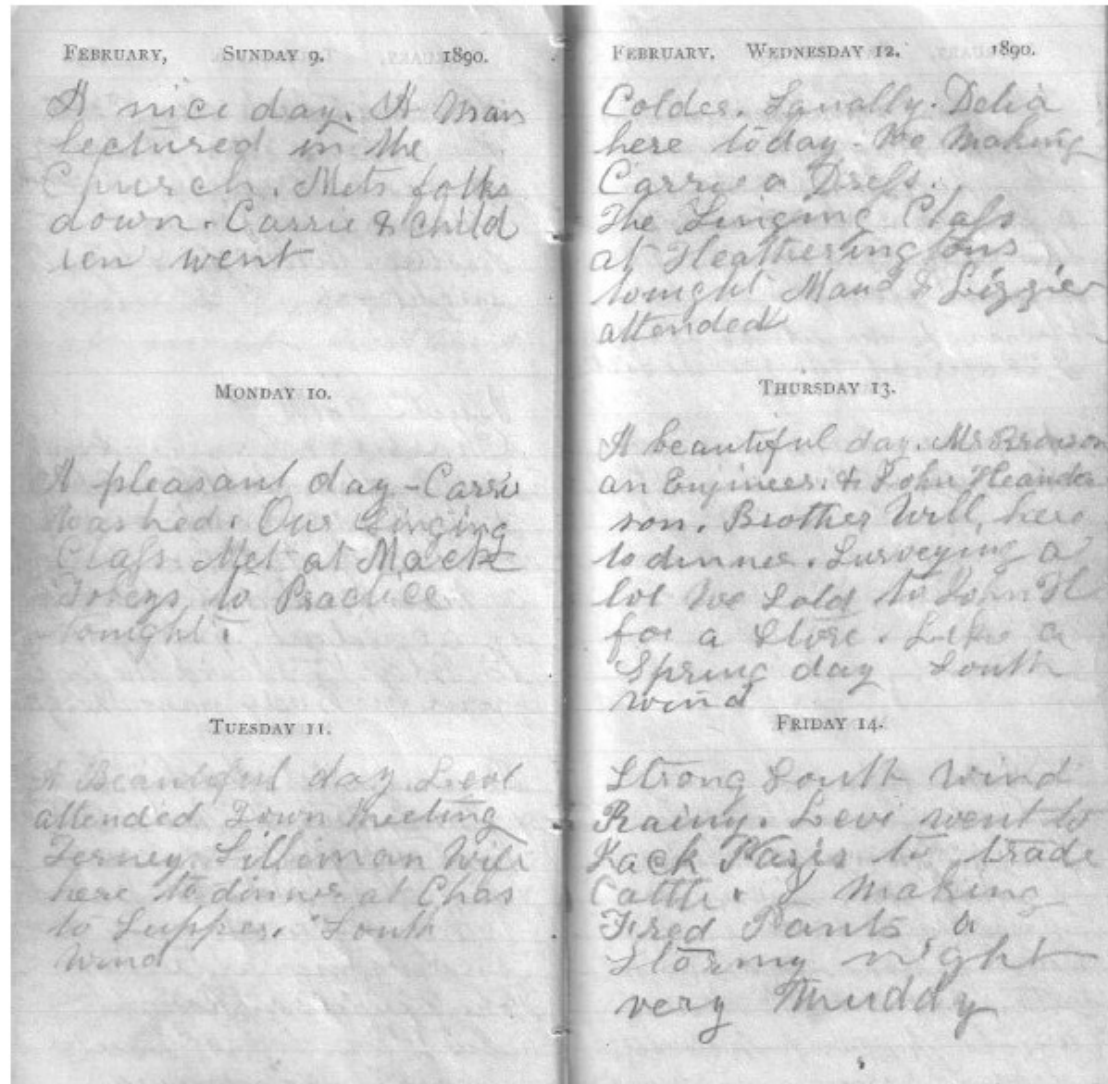


Two Pages from Elizabeth Hanford's 1890 Diary - February

Tuesday 11

A Beautiful day Levi attended Town Meeting Terney Silliman Wife here to dinner at Chas to Supper. South Wind
