
Two Pages from Elizabeth Hanford's 1890 Diary - April & May

I finished Cleaning my Pantry. Received pay for tub of Butter 18 ½ cts lb.

Sat., May 3
Strong South. Wind
Quite Warm.
Our Apricot &
Mulbery Trees Came
today. Children
has Bad Colds
