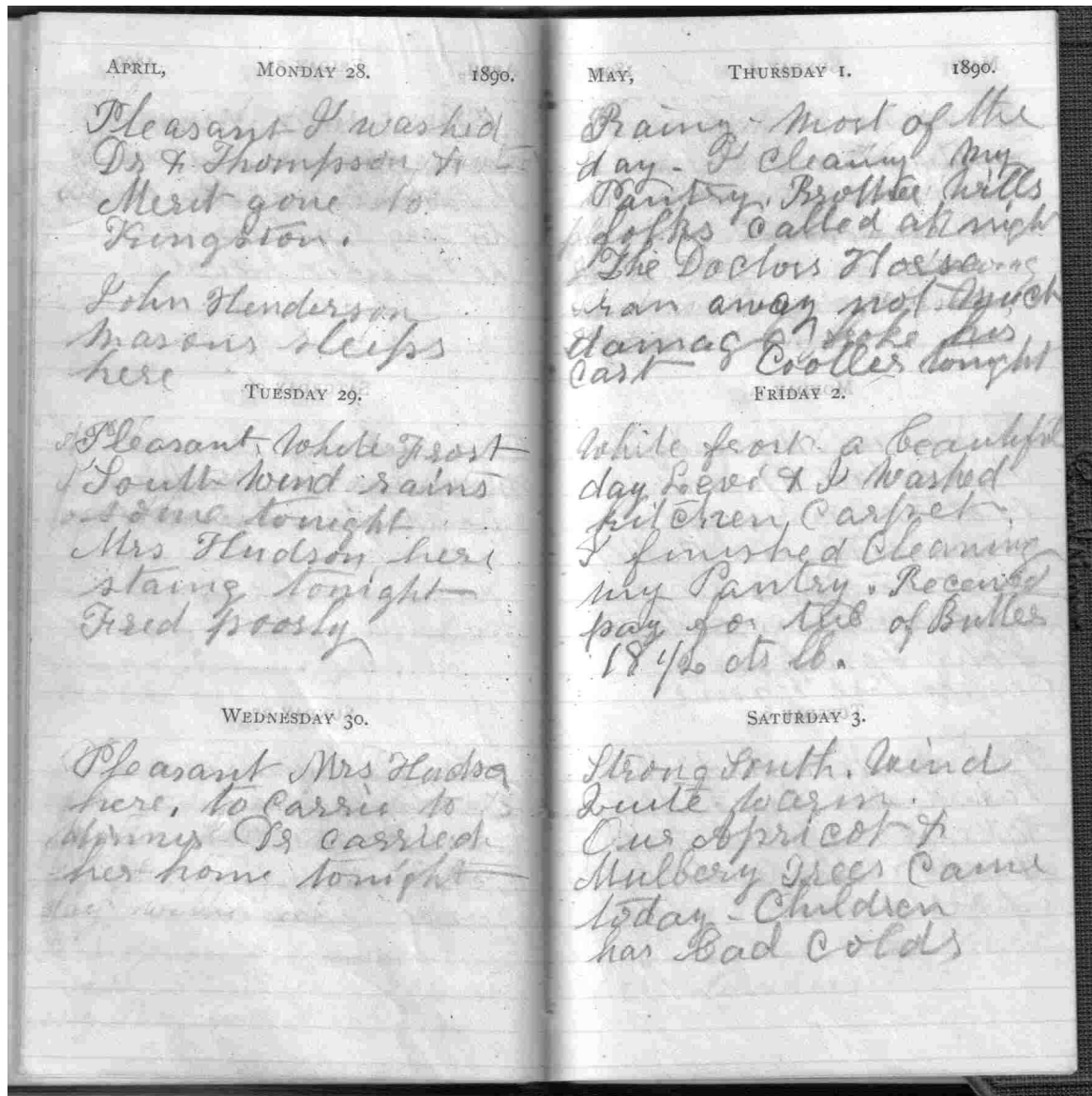


Two Pages from Elizabeth Hanford's 1890 Diary - April & May



Transcription:

Mon., April 28

Pleasant I washed Dr & Thompson & Merit gone to Kingston.

John Henderson Masons sleeps here

Tues., April 29

Pleasant White Frost South Wind rains some tonight Mrs Hudson here staing tonight Fred poorly

Wed. April 30

Pleasant Mrs Hudson here. to Carrie to dinner Dr carried her home tonight

Thurs., May 1

Rainy - Most of the day. I cleaning my Pantry. Brother Wills folks called at night The Doctors Horse ran away not much damage broke his cart Cooler tonight

Fri., May 2

White frost. a beautiful day. Levi & I Washed kitchen Carpet. I finished Cleaning my Pantry. Received pay for tub of Butter 18 1/2 cts lb.

Sat., May 3

Strong South. Wind Quite Warm. Our Apricot & Mulberry Trees Came today. Children has Bad Colds
